Thom Allison was born in Winnipeg, MB., began acting lessons at 10 and first graced the stage as part of a river in *The Tale of the Red Dragon* for Actors' Showcase (now Manitoba Theatre for Young People) at the age of 12. Other productions followed with Fantasy Theatre for Children and Manitoba Theatre Centre's acting program for young people, Manitoba Youth Theatre. His professional debut was at 16 in *Sweet Charity* for Rainbow Stage. He left for Ryerson Theatre School in Toronto soon after, returning often to work in shows and visit family.

Some select credits from across Canada include *Take Me Out, Outrageous the Musical* (Can-Stage), *Evita* (MTC/Theatre Calgary), *Berlin To Broadway* (Theatre Calgary), *Annie* (Grand Theatre), as well as playing Aldolpho in *The Drowsy Chaperone* at The Vancouver Playhouse, The Citadel (Edmonton), National Arts Centre (Ottawa) and Manitoba Theatre Centre. Thom was in the original Canadian companies of *Miss Saigon, The Who's Tommy* and *Rent*.

At The Stratford Festival, Thom has appeared in *Romeo and Juliet, Pericles, My Fair Lady, Threepenny Opera, The King and I,* and *King Henry VIII* and Peter Hinton's much heralded production of Sondheim's *Into the Woods* as Cinderella's Prince/Wolf. A previous season at the Shaw Festival, saw him in *Wonderful Town, A Little Night Music* and *Follies: In Concert.*

His Broadway debut came in the musical *Priscilla, Queen of the Desert* and this past year saw him return to the Shaw Festival in a critically acclaimed performance as Coalhouse Walker Jr. in *Ragtime*. His theatre work has seen him nominated for 2 Dora Awards (he was the host of this year's Dora Awards Show), 2 Betty Awards, a Jessie Award, an Ovation Award and a Sterling Award.

On television, Thom has most recently been seen as a judge on CBC's *Over the Rainbow*. Film work has included roles in *MVP* (Raoul), *Leaving Metropolis* (Shannon), *Last Dance* starring Patrick Swayze (Babysitter), *Road to Christmas* starring Jennifer Grey and Clark Gregg (Michele), and *I Me Wed* (Bill).
